It is expected that displaced persons from Ukraine will begin arriving in Buffalo in the coming weeks. It may range from dozens to hundreds of people. The details are still unclear.

These are probable characteristics of the displaced people :

- Mostly women and children. But there may be some families, and some men
- Limited English language skills. Speak primarily Ukrainian or Russian.
- Will not have Work Authorization in the USA.
- May be in various stages of the immigration process with USA Homeland Security : displaced person, asylum seeker, Temporary Protected Status, etc.
- May return to Ukraine when the war is over, and Ukraine is free again.

These are requirements for Host Persons and Host Families :

- Willing to provide a safe place to live, plus meals and reasonable accommodations for at least 6 months
- All adults in the Host Household must be willing to pay for, and pass, a police background check, including fingerprinting
- After initial acceptance you must provide pictures and a description of living arrangements
